- **Undergraduate:** Mean grade of C+ with C (plain) in Mathematics; or C plain with CPA part II. (For BBA, with IT). Applicants with CPA part II are eligible for exemptions for certain Year 1 courses.

NB: Exemptions: Applicants with CPA PART III are eligible for exemptions for certain Year 1, 2, 3 and 4 courses.
