WHO WE ARE

The Federation of Eastern Africa University Sports (FEAUS) is one of the five FASU Zones mandated to oversee university sports activities in Easten Africa. The Federation has a history that dates back to the 1950s during the times when the East Africa Community had one university; the University of East Africa, with three Colleges (Makerere, Nairobi and Dar es Salaam University Colleges).

Flagship event of FEAUS is the Eastern Africa University Games, which started in 1958 as inter collegiate games for the three constituent Colleges of the University of East Africa with 9 editions that sadly ended in 1973 when political challenges affected the region. These are the oldest inter-state games on the continent, that later gave birth to the East and Southern Africa University Sports Association (ECSAUSA) Games held in Lusaka 1983 and Kampala 1986.

FEAUS was revitalized in 1999 with the revival of the East Africa University Games at Egerton University in Kenya, and has a current membership of universities across the eastern region of Africa.

The Federation is governed by an Executive Board of 15 members, elected every four years, with a permanent secretariat located at Makerere University in Kampala Uganda. The current leadership was elected in March 2021 and will serve until March 2025.



CURRENT PROGRAMMES AND EVENTS

The organization has established a two-year calendar of events with various activities categorised under four major sectors including Administration, Sports Competitions, Mass Participation, Education and People Reforms (which covers PLWDs and Women).

The Zone also boasts of hosting numerous FASU and FISU events including 5 editions of the FASU Games, 7 FASU General Assemblies, 12 FASU championships, 3 FISU championships, 2 FISU Seminars and 2 Strategic dialogues among others.
