#### PART 1: INSTRUCTIONS TO TENDERERS

- 1. Tenderers are advised to read carefully these instructions and the Conditions of Contract in Part 3: Contract, before preparing the tender. The standard forms in this tender may be photocopied for completion but the Tenderer is responsible for their accurate reproduction. The *term Tenderer* shall mean the firm or person invited to submit a tender .The *term tender* herein shall mean the tender submitted as usually understood in public procurement.
- 2. Validity of Quotations: The quotation will be held valid for **sixtydays** (**60 Days**) from the date of submission.
- 3. The Quotation shall consist of completed Tables A, B and C and the Form of Quotation all indicated in Part 2 of this Request for Quotations, and documents to evidence Eligibility and Conformity to Technical Specifications.
- 4. Sealing and Marking of Quotations: Quotations in one "one original "should be sealed in a single envelope, clearly marked with the Quotation Reference Number in the RFQ, the Tenderer's name and the name of the Procuring Entity. Envelopes should be sealed in such a manner that opening and resealing cannot be achieved undetected.
- 5. **Submission of Quotations**: Quotations, and any alternatives if allowed as per Item 11 below, should be submitted to the address below, on or before the date and time indicated in sub-item 4 below. Late quotations will be rejected.

- 6. **Opening of tender**: tender will be opened immediately after the closing date and time specified in item 5(4) above, by at least three appointed Officials of the Procuring Entity.
- 7. **Tenderer Eligibility:** Tenderer must submit Documentary evidence to show His/her eligibility to be awarded a contract to cover each of the following: (i) Valid Trading License (ii) Certificate Of Registration, (iii) Valid Tax Compliance Certificate for the previous Financial Year. (iv) AGPO Certificate. The Tenderer shall also complete attached forms to confirm eligibility and non-existence of a conflict of interest in relation to this procurement requirement by signing the attached Forms.
- 8. **Invitation not transferable**: This invitation is not transferable to other firms or individuals not so invited.
- 9. **Goods Eligibility**: Tenderer must submit as evidence documents to show the country of origin of any goods to be supplied or incorporated in the work or services
- 10. **Technical Specifications**: Documentary evidence to show that the goods meet the technical specifications.
- 11. **Alternative tender**: Tenderers are not permitted to submit alternative tender for goods or Services. Only the alternatives, if any, of the Tenderer with the winning tender conforming to the basic technical requirements shall be considered by the Procuring Entity.
- 12. **Currency:** tender shall be priced in Kenya Shillings

#### APPENDIX TO THE PREFACE GUIDELINES FOR PREPARATION OF TENDER DOCUMENTS

#### 1. GENERAL

- a. Page1 (The Heading of the Document), the Preface and the Appendix shall not be included in the Document to be issued to Tenderers. The Document to be issued to Tenderers shall start with the page titled "This Page, NAME, LOGO AND ADDRESS OF THE PROCURING ENTITY, NAME AND IDENTIFICATION OF TENDER", including all the other material on the page completed appropriately.
- b. If in the course of preparing a Tender Document or evaluating a tender/tenders following the criteria in the standard tender document, a Procuring Entity finds a provision the PE does not understand or agree with, the PE shall contact PPRA for clarifications before it changes anything, otherwise the PE will be considered as violating procurement rules.
- c. The Procuring Entity should confirm that the goods to be procured is in the PE's approved Procurement Plan and budgeted for. The PE should also confirm the estimated cost of the contract(s), including the estimated time for executing the contract. The cost estimate helps the Procuring Entity determine the applicable procurement method to be used and the determination if the lowest evaluated cost is unrealistically too low or too high. Prior to finalizing the Tender Document It is advisable for the Procuring Entity to re check these estimates
- d. The estimates must be prepared by an expert in the field of the subject contract i.e.by Engineers, IT Specialists, or Procurement Specialists, depending on the Good to be procured. The Estimates should be based on current market prices or on data collected by the Procuring Entity based on past (*but not historic*) contracts.
- e. The purpose of the estimates is to enable the Procuring Entity determine amounts of money to be inserted in the Tender Document for the tender security.
- 2. Should be expressed in absolute value which should not be more than 2% of the tender as valued by the Procuring Entity. It is advisable that the larger the estimated contract value, the smaller the required percentage of the tender security.

#### 8. Section III - Evaluation and Qualification Criteria

- 9. This Section specifies the criteria to determine the Lowest Evaluated Tender that would be considered for contract award; that is the tenderer that meets the qualification criteria and whose tender has been determined to be:
- 10. Substantially responsive to the bidding document, and
- 11. The lowest evaluated cost.
- 12. No other criterion shall be added by the Procuring Entity. Some parts of this section may be omitted by the Procuring Entity (and not by a Tenderer) to suit the subject procurement. For example, in some cases evaluation may not include Margin of Preference, so any reference to considerations for Margin of Preference will be omitted. The Procuring Entity will complete the parts of the Criterion only as guided and allowed in this section. For example, if the criterion provides "Postqualification and Contract ward" and lists an item that says "Other conditions......" the Entity shall only include the conditions that are allowed in the Standard Tender Document.

#### 13. Section IV – Tendering Forms

14. #### SECTION I: INSTRUCTIONS TO TENDERERS

#### **A** General Provisions

#### 1. Scope of Tender

- 1.1 The Procuring Entity as defined in the **TDS** invites tenders for supply of goods and, if applicable, any Related Services incidental thereto, as specified in Section V, Supply Requirements. The name, identification, and number of lots (contracts) of this Tender Document are specified in the **TDS**.
- 12 Throughout this tendering document:
  - a) The term "in writing" means communicated in written form (e.g. by mail,
  - b) e-mail, fax, including if specified in the **TDS**, distributed or received through the electronic-procurement system used by the Procuring Entity) with proof of receipt;
  - c) if the context so requires ,"singular" means "plural" and vice versa;
  - d) "Day" means calendar day, unless otherwise specified as "Business Day". A Business Day is any day that is an official working day of the Procuring Entity. It excludes official public holidays.

#### 2 Fraud and Corruption

- The Procuring Entity requires compliance with the provisions of the Public Procurement and Asset Disposal Act, 2015, Section62 "Declaration not to engage incorruption". The tender submitted by a person shall include a declaration that the person shall not engage in any corrupt or fraudulent practice and a declaration that the person or his or her sub-contractors are not debarred from participating in public procurement proceedings.
- The Procuring Entity requires compliance with the provisions of the Competition Act 2010, regarding collusive practic cesin contracting. Anytender refound to have engaged in collusive conducts hall be disqualified and criminal and/orcivils anctions may be imposed. To this effect, Tenders shall be required to complete and sign the "Certificate of Independent Tender Determination" annexed to the Form of Tender.

- 245 Next, all remaining envelopes shall be opened one atatime, reading out: the name of the Tender er and whether there is a modification; the total Tender Prices, per lot (contract) if applicable, including any discounts and alternative Tenders; the presence or absence of a Tender Security, if required; and any other details as the Procuring Entity may consider appropriate.
- OnlyTenders,alternativeTendersanddiscountsthatareopenedandreadoutatTenderopeningshallbeconsideredfurt herforevaluation.TheFormofTenderandpagesoftheBillsofQuantitiesaretobeinitialedbythemembersofthetender openingcommitteeattendingtheopening.ThenumberofrepresentativesoftheProcuringEntitytosignshallbespecifiedintheTDS.
- 24.7 The Procuring Entity shall neither discuss the merits of any Tender nor reject any Tender (except for late Tenders, in accordance with ITT22.1).

  - a) The name of the Tenderer and whether there is a withdrawal, substitution, or modification;
  - b) the Tender Price, perlot (contract) if applicable, including any discounts;

  - d) the presence or absence of a Tender Security or Tender-Securing Declaration, if one was required;
  - e) Number of pages of each tender document submitted.
- 24.9 The Tenderers' representatives who are present shall be requested to sign the record. The omission of a Tenderer sign at ure on the records hall not invalidate the contents and effect of the record. A copy of the tender opening registers hall be is sued to a Tenderer upon request.

#### E. Evaluation and Comparison of Tenders

#### 25. Confidentiality

- 25.1 InformationrelatingtotheevaluationofTendersandrecommendationofcontractaward,shallnotbedisclosedtoTen derersoranyotherpersonsnotofficiallyconcernedwiththetenderingprocessuntiltheinformationonIntentiontoAw ardtheContractistransmittedtoallTenderersinaccordancewithITT41.
- 252 AnyeffortbyaTenderertoinfluencetheProcuringEntityintheevaluationorcontractawarddecisionsmayresultinthe rejectionofitsTender.
- Notwithstanding ITT 25.2, from the time of Tender opening to the time of Contract Award, if any Tenderer wishes to contact the Procuring Entity on any matter related to the Tendering process, it should do so in writing.

#### **26.** Clarification of Tenders

To assist in the examination, evaluation, comparison of the Tenders, and qualification of the Tenderers, the Procuring Entitymay, at its discretion, ask any Tenderer for a clarification of its Tender. Any clarification submitted by a Tenderer in respect to its Tender and that is not in response to a request by the Procuring Entity shall not be considered. The Procuring Entity's request for clarification and the responses hall be inwriting. No change, including any voluntary increase or decrease, in the prices or substance of the Tendershall be sought, offered, or permitted except to confirm the correction of farithmetic errors discovered by the Procuring Entity in the Evaluation of the Tenders, in accordance with ITT 30.

If a Tenderer does not provide clarifications of its Tender by the date and time set in the Procuring Entity's request for clarification, its Tender may be rejected.

#### 27. Deviations, Reservations, and Omissions

- 27.1 During the evaluation of Tenders, the following definitions apply:
  - a) "Deviation" isadeparture from the requirements specified in the Tendering document;
  - b) "Reservation" is the setting of limiting conditions or with holding from complete acceptance of the requirement specified in the tendering document; and
  - c) "Omission" isthefailure to submit part or all of the information or documentation required in the tendering document.

#### 28. Determination of Responsiveness

- 28.1 The Procuring Entity's determination of a Tender's responsiveness is to be based on the contents of the Tender itself, as defined in ITT 28.2.

#### 30. Arithmetical Errors

- 30.1 Thetendersum assubmitted and read out during the tender opening shall be absolute and final and shall not be the subject of correction, adjustment or amendment in anyway by any person or rentity.

  - a) motorvehicles, plantandequipment which are assembled in Kenya;
  - b) furniture,textile,foodstuffs,oilandgas,informationcommunicationtechnology,steel,cement,leatheragro-processing,sanitaryproducts,andothergoodsmadeinKenya;or
  - c) goods manufactured, mined, extracted or grown in Kenya.

- Whereitisintendedtoreserveacontracttoaspecificgroupofbusinesses(thesegroupsareSmallandMediumEnterprises,WomenEnterprises,YouthEnterprisesandEnterprisesofpersonslivingwithdisability,asthecasemaybe),andw hoareappropriatelyregisteredassuchbytheauthoritytobespecifiedinthe**TDS**,aprocuringentityshallensurethatthei nvitationtotenderspecificallyindicatesthatonlybusinessesorfirmsbelongingtothespecifiedgroupareeligibletoten derasspecifiedinthe**TDS**.No tender shall be reserved to more than one group.IfnotsostatedintheTenderdocuments,theinvitationtotenderwillbeopentoallinterestedtenderers.

#### 33. Evaluation of Tenders

- 333 TheestimatedeffectofthepriceadjustmentprovisionsoftheConditionsofContract,appliedovertheperiodofexecuti onoftheContract,shallnotbeconsideredinTenderevaluation.

- 35.1 AnAbnormallyLowTenderisonewheretheTenderprice,incombinationwithotherconstituentelementsoftheTend er,appearsunreasonablylowtotheextentthattheTenderpriceraisesmaterialconcernswiththeProcuringEntityastot hecapabilityoftheTenderertoperformtheContractfortheofferedTenderprice.
- 352 IntheeventofidentificationofapotentiallyAbnormallyLowTenderbytheevaluationcommittee,theProcuringEntit yshallseekwrittenclarificationfromtheTenderer,includingadetailedpriceanalysesofitsTenderpriceinrelationtoth esubjectmatterofthecontract,scope,deliveryschedule,allocationofrisksandresponsibilitiesandanyotherrequire mentsofthetenderingdocument.
- 353 Afterevaluationofthepriceanalysis, in the event that the Procuring Entity determines that the Tenderer has failed to de monstrateits capability to perform the contract for the offered Tender price, the Procuring Entity shall reject the Tende.

#### **36.** Abnormally High Tenders

- 36.4 Anabnormallyhighpriceisonewherethetenderprice,incombinationwithotherconstituentelementsoftheTender,a ppearsunreasonablytoohightotheextentthattheProcuringEntityisconcernedthatit(theProcuringEntity)maynotb egettingvalueformoneyoritmaybepayingtoohighapriceforthecontractcomparedwithmarketpricesorthatgenuine competitionbetweenTenderersiscompromised.
- 36.5 Incaseofanabnormallyhightenderprice, the Procuring Entityshallmake asurvey of the market prices, check if the esti mated cost of the contract is correct and review the Tender Documents to check if the specifications, scope of work and conditions of contract are contributory to the abnormally high tenders. The Procuring Entity may also seek written clarification from the tender erron the reason for the high tender price. The Procuring Entity shall proceed as follows:
  - i) If the tender price is a bnormally high based on wrong estimated cost of the contract, the Procuring Entity may accept to rnot accept the tender depending on the Procuring Entity's budget considerations.
  - ii) Ifspecifications,scopeofworkand/orconditionsofcontractarecontributorytotheabnormallyhightenderprice s,theProcuringEntityshallrejectalltendersandmayretenderforthecontractbasedonrevisedestimates,specifications,scopeofworkandconditionsofcontract,asthecasemaybe.

36.6 IftheProcuringEntitydeterminesthattheTenderPriceisabnormallytoohighbecausegenuinecompetitionbetweent enderersiscompromised(oftenduetocollusion,corruptionorothermanipulations),theProcuringEntityshallreject allTendersandshallinstituteorcauserelevantGovernmentAgenciestoinstituteaninvestigationonthecauseoftheco mpromise,beforeretendering.

#### 37. Post-Qualification of the Tenderer

- 37.1 The Procuring Entity shall determine, to its satisfaction, whether the eligible Tenderer that is selected as having submitted the lowest evaluated cost and substantially responsive Tender, meets the qualifying criteria specified in Section III, Evaluation and Qualification Criteria.
- ThedeterminationshallbebaseduponanexaminationofthedocumentaryevidenceoftheTendererqualificationssub mittedbytheTenderer,pursuanttoITT15and16.Thedeterminationshallnottakeintoconsiderationthequalification sofotherfirmssuchastheTenderersubsidiaries,parententities,affiliates,subcontractors(otherthanspecializedsubc ontractorsifpermittedinthetenderingdocument),oranyotherfirm(s)differentfromtheTenderer.
- AnaffirmativedeterminationshallbeaprerequisiteforawardoftheContracttotheTenderer.AnegativedeterminationshallresultindisqualificationoftheTender,inwhicheventtheProcuringEntityshallproceedtotheTendererwhooff ersasubstantiallyresponsiveTenderwiththenextlowestevaluatedcosttomakeasimilardeterminationofthatTendererqualificationstoperformsatisfactorily.

#### **38.** Lowest Evaluated Tender

- 38.1 Having compared the evaluated prices of Tenders, the Procuring Entity shall determine the Lowest Evaluated Tender. The Lowest Evaluated Tender is the Tender of the Tenderer that meets the Qualification Criteria and whose Tender has been determined to be:
  - a) Most responsive to the Tender document; and
  - b) The lowest evaluated price.

#### 39. Procuring Entity's Right to Accept Any Tender, and to Reject Any or All Tenders.

39.1 The Procuring Entity reserves the right to accept or reject any tender, and to annul the Tendering process and reject all Tenders at any time prior to notification Award, without thereby incurring any liability to Tenderers. In case of annulment, all Tenderers shall be notified with reasons and all Tenders submitted and specifically, tender securities, shall be promptly returned to the Tenderers.

#### F. Award of Contract

#### 40. Award Criteria

40.1 The Procuring Entity shall award the Contract to the successful tenderer whose tender has been determined to be the Lowest Evaluated Tenderina coordance with procedures in Section 3: Evaluation and Qualification Criteria.

#### 41. Procuring Entity's Right to Vary Quantities at Time of Award

The Procuring Entity reserves the right at the time of Contract award to increase or decrease, by the percentage (s) for items as indicated **in the TDS.** 

#### 42. Notice of Intention to enter into a Contract

UponawardofthecontractandPriortotheexpiryoftheTenderValidityPeriodtheProcuringEntityshallissueaNotific ationofIntentiontoEnterintoaContract/Notificationofawardtoalltendererswhichshallcontain,ataminimum,thefo llowinginformation:

- a) The name and address of the Tenderer submitting the successful tender;
- b) the Contract price of the successful tender;
- c) a statement of there a son(s) the tenderoftheunsuccessfultenderertowhomtheletterisaddressedwasunsuccessful,unlessthepriceinformatio nin(c)abovealreadyrevealsthereason;
- d) the expiry date of the Stand still Period and
- e) instructions on how to request a debriefing and / or submit a complaint during the stand still period;

#### 43. Stand still Period

#### 45. Letter of Award

Prior to the expiry of the Tender Validity Period and upon expiry of the Stand still Period specified in ITT 42, upon addressing a complaint that has been filed within the Stand still Period, the Procuring Entity shall transmit the Letter of Award to the successful Tenderer. The letter of award shall request the successful tenderer to furnish the Performance Security within 21 days of the date of the letter.

#### 46. Signing of Contract

- 46.1 Upon the expiry of the fourteen days of the Notification of Intention to enter in to contract and upon the parties meeting their respective statutory requirements, the Procuring Entity shall send the successful Tenderer the Contract Agreement.
- Within Seven (7) days of receipt to the Contract Agreement, the successful Tenderer shall sign, date, and return it to the Procuring Entity.
- The written contract shall be entered in to within the period specified in the notification of award and before expiry of the tender validity period.

#### **47.** Performance Security

- 492 A request for administrative review shall be made in the form provided under contract forms.

#### 1. Purpose

1.1 TheGovernmentofKenya'sAnti-

Corruption and Economic Crimelaws and their sanction's policies and procedures, Public Procurement and Asset Disposal Act (no.33 of 2015) and its Regulation, and any other Kenya's Actsor Regulations related to Fraudand Corruption, and similar of fences, shall apply with respect to Public Procurement Processes and Contracts that are governed by the laws of Kenya.

#### 2. Requirements

2.1 TheGovernmentofKenyarequiresthatallpartiesincludingProcuringEntities,Tenderers,(applica nts/proposers),Consultants,ContractorsandSuppliers;anySub-contractors,Sub-consultants,ServiceprovidersorSuppliers;anyAgents(whetherdeclaredornot);andanyoftheirPer sonnel,involvedandengagedinprocurementunderKenya'sLawsandRegulation,observethehighe ststandardofethicsduringtheprocurementprocess,selectionandcontractexecutionofallcontracts, andrefrainfromFraudandCorruptionandfullycomplywithKenya'slawsandRegulationsasperpar agraphs1.1above.

#### 2.2 Kenya's

public procurement and asset disposal act (no. 33 of 2015) under Section 66 describes rules to be followed and actions to be taken in dealing with Corrupt, Coercive, Obstructive, Collusive or Fraudulent practices, and Conflicts of Interest in procurement including consequences for offences committed. - The Performance Security shall be discharged by the Procuring Entity and returned to the Supplier not later than thirt y(30) days following the date of Completion of the Supplier's performance obligations under the Contract, including anywarranty obligations, unless specified otherwise in the SCC.

# 19. Copyright

19.1Thecopyrightinalldrawings,documents,andothermaterialscontainingdataandinformationfurnishedtotheProcuri ngEntitybytheSupplierhereinshallremainvestedintheSupplier,or,iftheyarefurnishedtotheProcuringEntitydir ectlyorthroughtheSupplierbyanythirdparty,includingsuppliersofmaterials,thecopyrightinsuchmaterialsshall remainvestedinsuchthirdparty.

#### 20. Confidential Information

20.1 TheProcuringEntityandtheSuppliershallkeepconfidentialandshallnot,withoutthewrittenconsentoftheotherpa rtyhereto,divulgetoanythirdpartyanydocuments,data,orotherinformationfurnisheddirectlyorindirectlybythe otherpartyheretoinconnectionwiththeContract,whethersuchinformationhasbeenfurnishedpriorto,duringorfo llowingcompletionorterminationoftheContract.Notwithstandingtheabove,theSuppliermayfurnishtoitsSub-Suppliersuchdocuments,data,andotherinformationitreceivesfromtheProcuringEntitytotheextentrequiredfort heSubSuppliertoperformitsworkundertheContract,inwhicheventtheSuppliershallobtainfromsuchSubSuppli

- erundertaking of confidentiality similar to that imposed on the Supplier under GCC Clause 20.
- 20.2 The Procuring Entity shall not use such documents, data, and other information received from the Supplier for any purpose sun related to the contract. Similarly, the Supplier shall not use such documents, data, and other information received from the Procuring Entity for any purpose other than the performance of the Contract.
- 20.3 Theobligation of a partyunder GCCS ub-Clauses 20.1 and 20.2 above, however, shall not apply to information that:
  - a) the Procuring Entity or Supplier need to share with other arms of Government or other bodies participating in the efinancing of the Contract; such parties shall dedisclosed in **the SCC**;
  - b) noworhereafterentersthepublicdomainthroughnofaultofthatparty;
  - c) canbeproventohavebeenpossessedbythatpartyatthetimeofdisclosureandwhichwasnotpreviouslyobtain ed,directlyorindirectly,fromtheotherparty;or
  - d) otherwiselawfullybecomesavailabletothatpartyfromathirdpartythathasnoobligationofconfidentiality.
- 20.4 TheaboveprovisionsofGCCClause20shallnotinanywaymodifyanyundertakingofconfidentialitygivenbyeithe rofthepartiesheretopriortothedateoftheContractinrespectoftheSupplyoranypartthereof.
- 20.5 The provisions of GCCC lause 20 shall survive completion or termination, for whatever reason, of the Contract.

### 21. Subcontracting

- 21.1 The Suppliers hall notify the Procuring Entity in writing of all subcontracts awarded under the Contractif notal ready specified in the Tender. Such notification, in the original Tender or laters hall not relieve the Supplier from any of its obligations, duties, responsibilities, or liability under the Contract.

### 22. Specifications and Standards

  - b) The Suppliers hall be entitled to disclaim responsibility for any design, data, drawing, specification or other document, or any modification thereof provided or designed by or on behalf of the Procuring Entity, by giving anotice of such disclaimer to the Procuring Entity.
  - c) Whereverreferences are made in the Contract to codes and standards in accordance with which it shall be executed, the edition or the revised version of such codes and standards shall be those specified in the Schedule of Requirements. During Contract execution, any changes in any such codes and standards shall be applied only after approval by the Procuring Entity and shall be treated in accordance with GCC clause 33.

# 23. Packing and Documents

- 23.1 The Suppliers hall provide such packing of the Goods as is required to prevent their damage or deterioration during transit of their final destination, as indicated in the Contract. During transit, the packing shall be sufficient to with stand, without limitation, rough hand ling and exposure to extreme temperatures, salt and precipitation, and open storage. Packing case size and weights shall take into consideration, where appropriate, there moteness of the goods' final destination and the absence of heavy hand ling facilities at all points in transit.

#### 24. Insurance

### 25. Transportation and Incidental Services

  - d) performanceorsupervisionormaintenanceand/orrepairofthesuppliedGoods,foraperiodoftimeagreedbyt heparties,providedthatthisserviceshallnotrelievetheSupplierofanywarrantyobligationsunderthisContra ct;and
  - e) trainingoftheProcuringEntity'spersonnel,attheSupplier'splantand/oron-site,inassembly,start-up,operation,maintenance,and/orrepairofthesuppliedGoods.
- 25.3 PriceschargedbytheSupplierforincidentalservices,ifnotincludedintheContractPricefortheGoods,shallbeagre eduponinadvancebythepartiesandshallnotexceedtheprevailingrateschargedtootherpartiesbytheSupplierforsi milarservices

# 26. Inspections and Tests

- **26.1** The Suppliers hall at its own expense and at no cost to the Procuring Entity carry out all such tests and/or inspections of the Goods and Related Services as a respecified in the SCC.
- Theinspections and tests may be conducted on the premises of the Supplier or its Subcontractor, at point of delivery, a nd/or at the Goods' final destination, or in another place in Kenyaas specified in the SCC. Subject to GCC Sub-Clause 26.3, if conducted on the premises of the Supplier or its Subcontractor, all reasonable facilities and assistance, including access to drawing and production data, shall be furnished to the inspector sat no charge to the Procuring Entity.

27.1ExceptasprovidedunderGCCClause32,iftheSupplierfailstodeliveranyoralloftheGoodsbytheDate(s)ofdeliveryo rperformtheRelatedServiceswithintheperiodspecifiedintheContract,theProcuringEntitymaywithoutprejudic etoallitsotherremediesundertheContract,deductfromtheContractPrice,asliquidateddamages,asumequivalent tothepercentagespecifiedintheSCCofthedeliveredpriceofthedelayedGoodsorunperformedServicesforeachw eekorpartthereofofdelayuntilactualdeliveryorperformance,uptoamaximumdeductionofthepercentagespecifiedinthoseSCC.Oncethemaximumisreached,theProcuringEntitymayterminatetheContractpursuanttoGCCCl ause35.

### 28. Warranty

- 28.1 The Supplier warrants that all the Goods are new, unused, and of the most recent or current models, and that they incorporate all recent improvements in design and materials, unless provided otherwise in the Contract.
- 282 SubjecttoGCCSub-Clause22.1(b),theSupplierfurtherwarrantsthattheGoodsshallbefreefromdefectsarisingfromanyactoromissio noftheSupplierorarisingfromdesign,materials,andworkmanship,undernormaluseintheconditionsprevailingi nthecountryoffinaldestination.
- Unlessotherwisespecifiedinthe SCC, thewarranty shall remain valid for twelve (12) months after the Goods, or any portion thereof as the case may be, have been delivered to and accepted at the final destination indicated in the SCC, or foreighteen (18) months after the date of shipment from the portor place of loading in the country of origin, which ever period concludes earlier.
- 28.4 The Procuring Entity shall give notice to the Supplier stating the nature of any such defects to gether with all available evidence thereof, promptly following the discovery thereof. The Procuring Entity shall afford all reasonable opport unity for the Supplier to inspect such defects.

- 29.1 The Suppliershall, subject to the Procuring Entity's compliance with GCCS ub-Clause 29.2, indemnify and hold harmless the Procuring Entity and its employees and officers from an dagain stany a ndall suits, actions or administrative proceedings, claims, demands, losses, damages, costs, and expenses of any nat ure, including attorney's fees and expenses, which the Procuring Entity may suffer as a result of any infringement or al leged infringement of any patent, utility model, registered design, trademark, copy right, or other intellectual proper tyright registered or otherwise existing at the date of the Contract by reason of:
  - a) theinstallationoftheGoodsbytheSupplierortheuseoftheGoodsinthecountrywheretheSiteislocated;and
  - b) thesaleinanycountryoftheproductsproducedbytheGoods.
    - Such in demnity shall not cover any use of the Goods or any part thereof other than for the purpose indicated by or to be reasonably inferred from the Contract, neither any infringement resulting from the use of the Goods or any part thereof, or any products produced the reby in association or combination with any other equipment, plant, or materials not supplied by the Supplier, pursuant to the Contract.

### 30. LimitationofLiability

  - a) the Suppliers hall not be liable to the Procuring Entity, whether incontract, tort, or otherwise, for any indirector consequential loss or damage, loss of production, or loss of profits or interest costs, provided that this exclusions hall not apply to any obligation of the Supplier to pay liquidated damages to the Procuring Entity, and
  - b) the aggregate liability of the Supplier to the Procuring Entity, whether under the Contract, intortor otherwise, shall not exceed the total Contract Price, provided that this limitation shall not apply to the cost of repairing or replacing defective equipment, or to any obligation of the supplier to indemnify the Procuring Entity with respect to patent in fringement.

# 31. Change in Laws and Regulations

31.1 UnlessotherwisespecifiedintheContract,ifafterthedateof30dayspriortodateofTendersubmission,anylaw,regu lation,ordinance,orderorbylawhavingtheforceoflawisenacted,promulgated,abrogated,orchangedinKenya(w hichshallbedeemedtoincludeanychangeininterpretationorapplicationbythecompetentauthorities)thatsubseq uentlyaffectstheDeliveryDateand/ortheContractPrice,thensuchDeliveryDateand/orContractPriceshallbecor respondinglyincreasedordecreased,totheextentthattheSupplierhastherebybeenaffectedintheperformanceofa nyofitsobligationsundertheContract.Notwithstandingtheforegoing,suchadditionalorreducedcostshallnotbes eparatelypaidorcreditedifthesamehasalreadybeenaccountedforinthepriceadjustmentprovisionswhereapplica ble,inaccordancewithGCCClause15.

### 32. Force Majeure

- 32.1 The Suppliers hall not be liable for for feiture of its Performance Security, liquidated damages, or termination for default if and to the extent that its delay in performance or other failure to perform its obligations under the Contract is the result of an event of Force Majeure.
- Forpurposesofthis Clause, "Force Majeure" means an eventor situation beyond the control of the Supplier that is not foresee able, is un avoidable, and its originis not due to negligence or lack of care on the part of the Supplier. Such event smayinclude, but not be limited to, acts of the Procuring Entity in its sovereign capacity, wars or revolutions, fires, flo ods, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, and freight embargoes.
- 32.3 IfaForceMajeuresituationarises,theSuppliershallpromptlynotifytheProcuringEntityinwritingofsuchconditio nandthecausethereof.UnlessotherwisedirectedbytheProcuringEntityinwriting,theSuppliershallcontinuetope rformitsobligationsundertheContractasfarasisreasonablypractical,andshallseekallreasonablealternativemea nsforperformancenotpreventedbytheForceMajeureevent.

### 33. Change Orders and Contract Amendments

- 33.1 The Procuring Entity may at any time order the Supplier through notice in accordance GCC Clause 8, to make change swithin the general scope of the Contractinany one or more of the following:
  - a) drawings,designs,orspecifications,whereGoodstobefurnishedundertheContractaretobespecificallyman ufacturedfortheProcuringEntity;
  - b) themethodofshipmentorpacking;
  - c) theplaceofdelivery; and
  - d) theRelatedServicestobeprovidedbytheSupplier.

- 33.2 Ifanysuchchangecausesanincreaseordecreaseinthecostof,orthetimerequiredfor,theSupplier'sperformanceofa nyprovisionsundertheContract,anequitableadjustmentshallbemadeintheContractPriceorintheDelivery/Com pletionSchedule,orboth,andtheContractshallaccordinglybeamended.AnyclaimsbytheSupplierforadjustment underthisClausemustbeassertedwithintwenty-eight(28)daysfromthedateoftheSupplier'sreceiptoftheProcuringEntity'schangeorder.
- 33.3 PricestobechargedbytheSupplierforanyRelatedServicesthatmightbeneededbutwhichwerenotincludedintheC ontractshallbeagreeduponinadvancebythepartiesandshallnotexceedtheprevailingrateschargedtootherparties bytheSupplierforsimilarservices.
- **ValueEngineering:** The Supplier may prepare, at its own cost, a value engineering proposal at any time during the performance of the contract. The value engineering proposal shall, at a minimum, include the following;
  - a) theproposedchange(s), and a description of the difference to the existing contract requirements;
  - b) afullcost/benefitanalysisoftheproposedchange(s)includingadescriptionandestimateofcosts(includinglif ecyclecosts)theProcuringEntitymayincurinimplementingthevalueengineeringproposal;and
  - c) adescriptionofanyeffect(s)ofthechangeonperformance/functionality.
- 33.5 The Procuring Entity may accept the value engineering proposal if the proposal demonstrates benefits that:
  - a) acceleratesthedeliveryperiod; or
  - b) reduces the Contract Price or the lifecycle costs to the Procuring Entity; or
  - c) improves the quality, efficiency or sustainability of the Goods; or
  - d) yieldsanyotherbenefitstotheProcuringEntity,withoutcompromisingthenecessaryfunctionsoftheFaciliti es.
- 33.6 IfthevalueengineeringproposalisapprovedbytheProcuringEntityandresultsin:
  - a) areductionoftheContractPrice;theamounttobepaidtotheSuppliershallbethepercentagespecifiedintheSC CofthereductionintheContractPrice;or
  - b) anincreaseintheContractPrice; but results in a reduction in lifecycle costs due to any benefit described in (a) to (d) above, the amount to be paid to the Suppliers hall be the full increase in the Contract Price.
- 33.7 Subject to the above, novariation in ormodification of the terms of the Contract shall be made except by written amendment signed by the parties.

#### 34. Extensions of Time

- 34.1 IfatanytimeduringperformanceoftheContract,theSupplieroritssubcontractorsshouldencounterconditionsimp edingtimelydeliveryoftheGoodsorcompletionofRelatedServicespursuanttoGCCClause13,theSuppliershallp romptlynotifytheProcuringEntityinwritingofthedelay,itslikelyduration,anditscause.Assoonaspracticableafte rreceiptoftheSupplier'snotice,theProcuringEntityshallevaluatethesituationandmayatitsdiscretionextendtheS upplier'stimeforperformance,inwhichcasetheextensionshallberatifiedbythepartiesbyamendmentoftheContra ct.
- 34.2 ExceptincaseofForceMajeure,asprovidedunderGCCClause32,adelaybytheSupplierintheperformanceofitsD eliveryandCompletionobligationsshallrendertheSupplierliabletotheimpositionofliquidateddamagespursuant toGCCClause26,unlessanextensionoftimeisagreedupon,pursuanttoGCCSub-Clause34.1.

### 35. Termination

- 35.1 TerminationforDefault
  - a) TheProcuringEntity,withoutprejudicetoanyotherremedyforbreachofContract,bywrittennoticeofdefault senttotheSupplier,mayterminatetheContractinwholeorinpart:
    - i) ifthe Supplier fails to deliver any or all of the Goods within the period specified in the Contract, or within a nyextension thereof granted by the Procuring Entity pursuant to GCCC lause 34;
    - ii) iftheSupplierfailstoperformanyotherobligationundertheContract;or
    - iii) ifthe Supplier, in the judgment of the Procuring Entity has engaged in Fraudand Corruption, as defined in paragraph 2.2 a of the Appendix to the GCC, in competing for or in executing the Contract.
  - b) IntheeventtheProcuringEntityterminatestheContractinwholeorinpart,pursuanttoGCCClause35.1(a),th eProcuringEntitymayprocure,uponsuchtermsandinsuchmannerasitdeemsappropriate,GoodsorRelated Servicessimilartothoseundeliveredornotperformed,andtheSuppliershallbeliabletotheProcuringEntityf oranyadditionalcostsforsuchsimilarGoodsorRelatedServices.However,theSuppliershallcontinueperfor

manceoftheContracttotheextentnotterminated.

# 352 Termination for Insolvency.

The Procuring Entity may at any time terminate the Contract by giving notice to the Supplier if the Supplier becomes bankruptor otherwise in solvent. In such event, termination will be without compensation to the Supplier, provided that such termination will not prejudice or affect any right of action or remedy that has accrued or will accrue the reaftert othe Procuring Entity.

#### 35.2 Termination for Convenience.

- a) TheProcuringEntity,bynoticesenttotheSupplier,mayterminatetheContract,inwholeorinpart,atanytimef oritsconvenience. ThenoticeofterminationshallspecifythatterminationisfortheProcuringEntity'sconvenience,theextenttowhichperformanceoftheSupplierundertheContractisterminated,andthedateuponwhichsuchterminationbecomeseffective.
- b) TheGoodsthatarecompleteandreadyforshipmentwithintwenty-eight(28)daysaftertheSupplier'sreceiptofnoticeofterminationshallbeacceptedbytheProcuringEntityatth eContracttermsandprices.FortheremainingGoods,theProcuringEntitymayelect:
  - i) tohaveanyportioncompletedanddeliveredattheContracttermsandprices; and/or
  - ii) tocanceltheremainderandpaytotheSupplieranagreedamountforpartiallycompletedGoodsandRel atedServicesandformaterialsandpartspreviouslyprocuredbytheSupplier.

### 36. Assignment

36.1

Neither the Procuring Entity nor the Supplier shall assign, in whole or in part, their obligations under this Contract, except with prior written consent of the other party.

# 37. Export Restriction

37.1

Notwithstanding any obligation under the Contract to complete all export formalities, any export restrictions attributable to the Procuring Entity, to Kenya, or to the use of the products/goods, systems or services to be supplied, which a rise from trade regulations from a country supplying those products/goods, systems or services, and which substantially impede the Supplier from the obligation sunder the Contract, shall release the Supplier from the obligation to provide deliveries or services, always provided, however, that the Supplier can demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Procuring Entity that it has completed all formalities in a timely manner, including applying for permits, authorizations and licenses necessary for the export of the products/goods, systems or services under the terms of the Contract. Termination of the Contract on this basis shall be for the Procuring Entity's convenience pursuant to Sub-Clause 35.3.
